## SummerStage Delafield Press Kit

Summerstage of Delafield is an outdoor theater located in the beautiful Lapham Peak Unit of the Kettle Moraine State Forest which is located on Highway C one mile south of Delafield, Wisconsin in the heart of the Lake Country area located 30 miles west of Milwaukee. The current setup includes a stage with a roof in a natural amphitheater setting just off the lighted hiking/ski trail, a tech booth, a concession stand, a picnic tent, and a ticket gazebo. SummerStage In the summer months, the SummerStage schedule includes:

- Broadway series plays
- Music series events of multiple genres
- Family events (which are free events)
- Chamber Music Series events
- Community Outreach events
- Event by other non-profits

SummerStage is located in the Lapham Peak Unit of the Southern Kettle Moraine Stage Forest, one mile south of Interstate Highway I-94 on Highway C. The address is Lapham Peak Unit – Kettle Moraine State Forest W329 N846 County Highway C Delafield, WI 53018

Seating is unassigned (festival-style) and available on a first come, first served basis. Bring your own chair or rent one onsite. You may carry in food and drinks or purchase them from our concession stand. Please note that there is a \$5 per vehicle parking fee. It's free if you have a WI State Park Sticker.
